Gear Recommendation

You never want your gear or lack of equipment to be the reason or excuse for performing poorly at a wedding. There is only one chance to get it right. For those reasons, I have outlined what I believe to be the minimum gear you would need to photograph a wedding. I've also recommended additional gear that will give you a more well rounded kit.

Minimum Kit

Camera

2 camera bodies

Lenses

- 24-70mm f/2.8
- 70-200mm f/2.8 VR

Lighting

- 2 flashes, one for each camera
- 1 flash remote trigger
- 1 portable continuous light source
- 5-in-1 Reflector
- Strobe with a modifier

Additional Gear

Macro lens for detail shots

- 105mm f/2.8 VR

Fast lenses

- 85mm f/1.8
- 50mm f/1.2 or 50mm f/1.8

Good all around

- 24-120mm f/4
